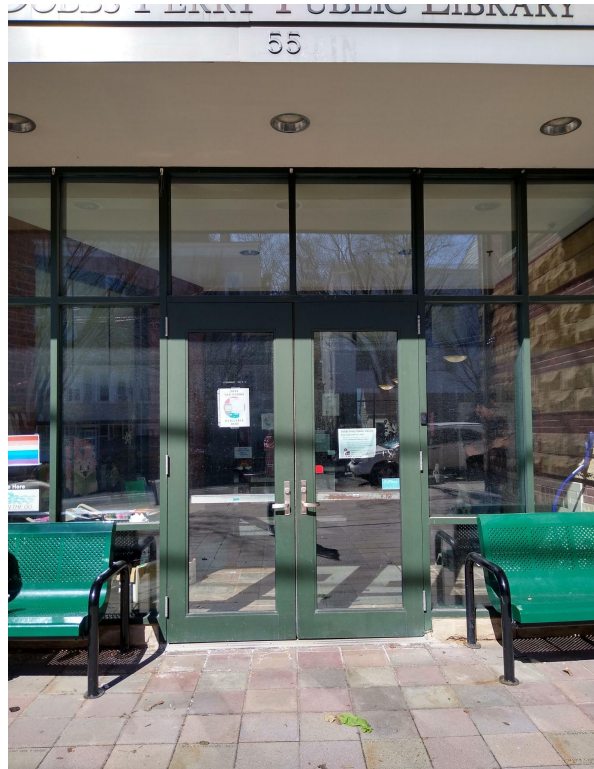
Note to Caregivers

I push the doors open when I walk in.



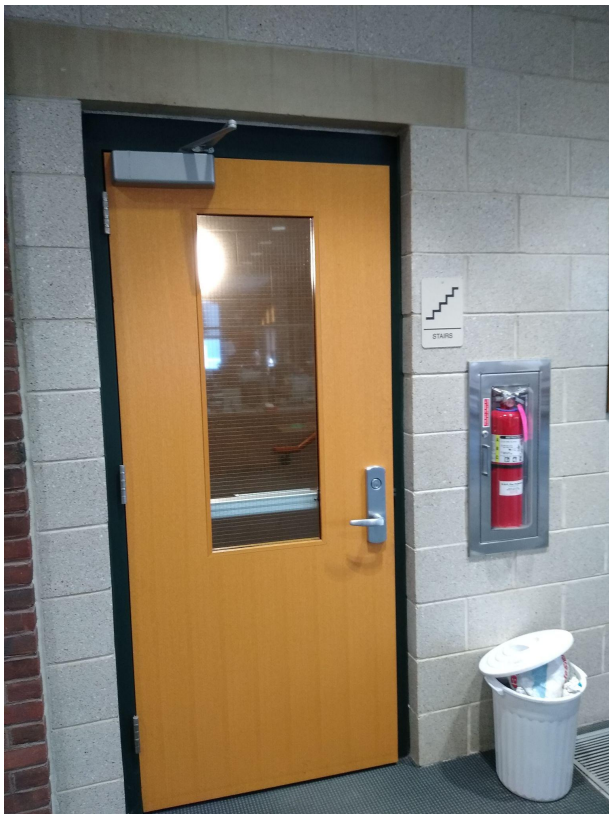
There are more doors after the front door.

I can ask the librarian for help finding books.



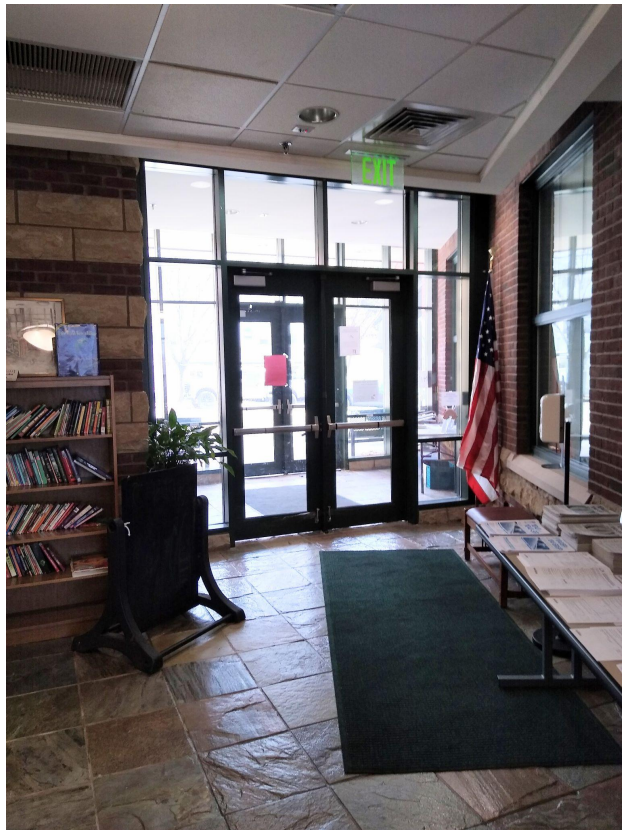
I can use the computers to go on the internet or type something up.
